

1. Format

Two Person four-ball match play for points

The two players on the team play their own ball. The better ball of the two competes against the better ball of the opponent for win of the hole (gross or net).

Points will be awarded with the GROSS winner being awarded One point and the NET winner being awarded ONE point for the first nine holes.

The next nine is scored the same.

After 18 holes are played (Overall score), one-half point is awarded to each team when one wins Gross and one wins Net.

In the event of a tie match (in Net and Gross), one-half point is awarded to each team.

On Regular Match Play days there will be a maximum of 18 points than can be won by a team

In the four-ball match, the lowest handicap player will play at scratch and each of the other three players in the group will receive the full difference in strokes as they fall on the score card.

2. Upon finishing your round, check with opponents to ensure both scorecards show the same results and signed

3. Turn your **scorecard** into the day's designated captain. The captain with proof the cards and turn them into the OGA official.

4. OGA will **post** the scores as Tournaments.

5. To **speed up play**, if you are out of the hole pick up and write down the score you would most likely get or max equitable stroke score). If hole has been conceded pick up your ball, don't continue putting.
