All winnings are merchandise credits posted to your account in the pro shop.

PLEASE NOTE: In order to have the approximate same number of players in each flight, USGA Handicap Indexes will determine flight placement, as is standard practice. In order to be eligible for winnings payout, individual scorecards must be signed and attested. Please note each player is scored in the group they signed up for and began play with. An 18-hole player cannot quit after playing 9 holes and move to the 9-hole group, nor can a 9-hole player continue to play 18 and move to the 18-hole group.

There will need to be a minimum of four (4) members playing 9 holes and four (4) members playing 18 holes to have a payout in each group (a foursome is not required, but you must play your round with a CWGA member).

There were 6 scorecards DQ in this weeks Days Play. There was one DNF scorecards in this weeks Days Play.

The Scoring Committee regrets that the Nine-Hole players had many problems, including some playing the wrong course and a few switching from 9 to 18. Apparently, when making their tee times, these players failed to request 9 holes, (or the Pro Shop failed to note it in the reservation), so players were sent to the wrong course. Regardless of who was at fault, it is impossible for the Scoring Committee to adjust winnings and winners when half the field played the wrong course. All of those players were disqualified from the competition.

We hope with the new system in place, these issues will go away. Please pay attention to the two emails being sent by Day's Play representatives and click "Playing" on the correct one. One will invite you to play 9, while the other will invite you to play 18. Be sure to accept the correct one and Golf Genius will do the rest.
